

THE IMPORTANT STUFF, PLEASE READ:

1. It is the responsibility of all officials and competitors to ensure they have knowledge of the rules and comply with the rules. When you enter an event, you accept the rules and agree to abide by them. Breckland Carriage Driving Club runs its events in accordance with the Breckland Carriage Driving Club Rules and, where rules for competitions are non-existent, then the rules will be taken from the British Carriagedriving Rule Book or the FEI Rule Book for that event.
2. Drivers and Handlers must have third-party public liability insurance which covers them for attending and taking part in this event. Members of the Breckland Carriage Driving Club are covered for insurance through British Carriagedriving at club events. Non-members must provide proof of third-party public liability insurance with entry. This can be in the form of a membership card for British Carriagedriving, membership from a British Carriagedriving club, BHS Gold, British Driving Society (restricted to competitions run under Optimum time only) or a personal insurance policy covering equestrian activities.
3. The driver must be the first person to mount the carriage and last person to dismount the carriage. A groom must be in attendance at the head of the horse or pony when the driver is mounting or dismounting the carriage. The bridle must not be removed from the horse until it has been unhitched from the carriage and secured by a head collar.
4. Whenever a horse is driven, a groom must be on the carriage or, if there is no seat available, at hand to provide assistance.
5. Under no circumstances should a horse be attached to the carriage and left without a person in the Driver's seat. ALWAYS ensure a person is in the Driver's seat when the horse is attached to the carriage.
6. Cruelty to or abuse of any animal (including dogs) by any person at an event is forbidden. Anyone found abusing an animal will be disqualified from the event.
7. Equines must be 4 years of age or over to compete in driving classes.
8. Drivers, Handlers and Grooms must wear securely fastened protective headgear. Body/back protectors are recommended and Mandatory for any competition that includes a marathon type obstacle..
9. At all times, whilst on a carriage, all persons under the age of 18 must wear a body protector and securely fastened protective headgear. Infringement will result in Elimination.
10. Drivers of very small ponies (under 12hh) put to a two-wheel carriage, may compete without a groom seated on the carriage, but the groom must be in the arena and ready to assist the driver. This includes Tandems. A small pony put to a two-wheel carriage and driven by a junior driver must have a groom seated on the carriage at all times. Very Small Pony Team drivers may have one groom unmounted in the arena.
11. Depending on the number of entrants, a turnout may be driven by up to two drivers in a competition.

Note about your wheel widths: If you have a 3-phase trials carriage, set the wheel width to 125cm. All other suitable carriages for these competitions catered for, just include your wheel width on the entry form. Wheels widths may be measured on the day.

CONES FAULT COMPETITION - OPTIMUM TIME

The competition is judged on optimum time. No timing device is to be worn by the competitor or the groom or be present on the carriage during the competition. The competitor incurs 1 penalty for each second commenced either side of the optimum time and 3 penalties for a dislodged ball.

CLASS 1: Open Single turnout

CLASS 2: Open Multiple turnout

CONES ACCUMULATOR

The competitor drives as many cone obstacles in the time allowed of 3 minutes. 3 points are scored for each obstacle driven clear. No points are given for driving an obstacle that has a dislodged ball. When the time allowed is reached, a signal is given. The competitor will be awarded points for the last obstacle driven provided the nose of the horse had crossed the line between the cones at the moment when the signal was given. The competition is decided on the number of points accumulated.

CHRISTMAS STAKES PRECISION & SPEED

The course is divided into two sections. The first (precision) section consists of five to seven cone obstacles to test the driver's precision skills, such as combinations obstacles like the ZigZag. This section is driven not against the clock. The competitor then proceeds onto the speed section that consists of six to eight cone obstacles to be driven at speed as in a Derby. Finish of the precision section is start of the speed section. Penalties for dislodging a ball in the Precision section is 10 and in the Speed section 10 seconds are added to the time.

Drivers and Grooms to wear back protectors in this class.

TWO-ROUND DERBY

The Derby is a Combined Obstacle & Cones competition, more familiarly known as a World Cup style competition, where competitors drive a course of cones and up to two marathon type obstacles. The Derby is run as a speed competition where penalties for dislodged balls are converted into seconds and added to the time.

Drivers and Grooms to wear back protectors in this class.

CLASS 7: Open Single turnout

CLASS 8: Open Multiple turnout

SIX CONES - WINNER TAKES ALL

Class 9: Six obstacles placed in a straight line. The obstacles to be driven at trot pace. The cones become narrower as the competition progresses. Carriages must be 125cm wheel width. **BEST SINGLE AND MULTIPLE TURNOUTS WILL SPLIT THE ENTRY FEES AS PRIZE MONIES!**

All Single Turnout classes will be split if entries warrant on the Driver's indoor/ outdoor grade e.g. Prenovice, Novice/Intermediate and Open, so please include your grade on the entry form or we will assume you are OPEN.
